















O2 Czech Republic successfully refinanced its current debt and drew a new loan of up to CZK 12 billion

Pursuant to the article 119b paragraph 3 of the Act No. 256/2004 Coll., on Capital Market Undertakings, O2 Czech Republic a.s. (hereinafter the Company) announces that on December 16, 2015 it entered into Loan Facility Agreements in the total amount of up to CZK 12 billion. These facilities were jointly arranged by Komerční banka, a.s. (also acting as an agent), Česká spořitelna, a.s., Československá obchodní banka, a.s., UniCredit Bank Czech Republic and Slovakia, a.s., Raiffeisenbank a.s., Citibank Europe plc. and Tatra banka, a.s.

The Company benefited from favourable market conditions and will use this 5-year loan for refinancing of the current debt and also for general corporate purposes, including financing of the share buy-back, whose conditions have been approved by the General Meeting of the Company held on December 8, 2015. Overall loan terms and conditions and facilities structure enables the Company to maintain flexibility in managing its business in agile way.
